



Polynesian Adventure Tours, LLC, will not be liable for any injury, loss, damage, or accident to person or property of any individual on the tour from any cause beyond its control. On occasion, due to various factors, tours may be operated in reverse order but all tour components will be maintained.

Volcano tours: We do not guarantee viewing of lava due to external factors outside of our control. Covered, walking shoes are recommended. This tour is not recommended for people with asthma or respiratory conditions that may be exacerbated due to exposure to volcanic fumes.

Pearl Harbor One Day tours: Due to increased security measures, all purses, handbags, backpacks, fanny packs, camera bags, diaper bags, luggage and/or any type of bag that can conceal an object are NOT permitted inside Pearl Harbor, the Visitor's Center, or to any of the attractions. A storage facility is available for a fee at the entrance to the National Park. Strollers are not permitted in the theater or shuttle boats. Cameras and camcorders are allowed - be sure to bring yours! Due to external factors outside of our control (including inclement weather and/or shortages of Arizona boat launch tickets), there is a possibility of not being able to visit the Arizona Memorial during your tour. In such a case, you will still be able to visit the many Arizona exhibits and visitor's center, the Bowfin Submarine and other park monuments. PUC #974C
